

GEORGIA, Murray County MINUTES

The Murray County Commissioner held a public meeting Tuesday, May 7, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. in the hearing room of the Murray County courthouse Annex.

Commissioner Pittman called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance.

By signature and execution the minutes of April, 2013 were approved.

With no additions or deletions to the agenda, Commissioner Pittman adopted the agenda as presented.

Under new business the following items were addressed and approved.

- A. Approved Murray County Land Used Development Planning
Commission Minutes Dated April 16, 2013**

The meeting was called to order by Co-Chairman David McDaniel

First order of business was approval of the agenda. Motion to approve the agenda made by Edward Dunn, 2nd by Terry Wilson, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried. Motion to approve the minutes by Terry Wilson, 2nd by Edward Dunn, all in favor, none opposed, motion carried.

No Old Business

New Business: Co-Chairman McDaniel read rules of order and opened the public portion of the meeting.

Item 1. Re-Classification of property from SR to AG, owned by Saul Rangel, located at 4191 Hwy 225 North being a 9.32 acre tract of land in land lot 81 district 9 of Murray County. Mr. Rangel was present for the meeting and stated he would like to keep a few chickens, goats and sheep on his property. Dick Barnes said the request was in order for presenting and this parcel was large enough to be AG, but in reviewing the future land use map he recommends the board approve a conditional use instead of rezoning. Nancy Young said all notices had been sent. No one present for or against the request. Public portion of the hearing closed for board discussion. It was explained to Mr. Rangel about the change from rezone to conditional use and he said he would agree to that.

Edward Dunn made a motion to approve request with the maximum of 10 goats and sheet and 20 chickens, 2nd by Terry Wilson, all in favor, none opposed, motion approved.

Item 2. Map Review, Mr. Barnes presented the board members with a future land use map to study and recommend changes to tracts of land that would have a better use as commercial or industrial or residential. The map review will be an on going item for the land use board. Edward Dunn asked about an overlay of the map showing the Hwy 225 By-Pass.

Motion made by Edward Dunn to adjourn, 2nd by Terry Wilson, all in favor, none opposed , meeting adjourned.
