THE CODE OF MURRAY COUNTY

STATE OF GEORGIA

COUNTY OF MURRAY

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Murray County has determined that it is in the best interest of the public to amend the Murray County Code, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Murray County finds such amendments to be useful, necessary, and proper, and protective of the environment, and the health, welfare, and safety of the public, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT SO RESOLVED, by the Murray County Commissioner, that the Murray County Code be amended as follows:

Under Chapter 54, Roads, Article IV, Hauling and Logging, Sec. 54-181, Exemptions, shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 54-181. - Exemptions.

Small and limited operations of less than three acres in size, and/or less than 100 hours in duration, may be exempt from all or part of the Bonding and/or Temporary Exit requirements of this article, at the discretion of the Murray County Public Works Director or designee. Sites using Existing Driveways may also be exempt from all or part of the Temporary Exit requirements at the discretion of the Murray County Public Works Director or designee.
