

MINUTES

January 4, 2022 County Commissioner Meeting
Hearing Room of the Murray County Annex – 9:00am

Commissioner Hogan called the meeting to order (via phone conference) and welcomed those in attendance. The minutes of the previous meeting were adopted and approved.

Commissioner Hogan asked if there were any requests to be added to the agenda. No additions or deletions were requested, and the agenda was approved.

Under new business, the following items were addressed:

- A. Approval of Murray County Land Use and Development Planning Commission Meeting minutes. Items 1-4 were approved & Items 5-9 were tabled until a later date.
- B. Resolution: Setting qualifying fees for Murray County's 2022 elections. The fees were set at \$2,056.43 for Chief Magistrate Judge and \$20.00 for the Board of Education-Districts 5, 6, 7.
- C. Grant Award: 2022 GDOT Local Maintenance & Improvement Grant (LMIG) Quick Response for Shawnee Trail repairs \$200, 000. The Grant Award was announced.
- D. Grant Application: 2022 GDOT Local Maintenance & Improvement Grant (LMIG). Commissioner announced the county's intent to submit the application to GDOT. The application requested \$696,855 to resurface county roads.
- E. Grant Application: Hazard Mitigation Plan was submitted, and the Commissioner announced FEMA's intent to provide \$25,500 in Federal Aid to Murray County.
