Summary

Murray County Commissioner's Meeting

April 4, 2023

The Sole Commissioner of Murray County, Greg Hogan, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., April 4, 2023, in the Hearing Room of the Murray County Annex. In attendance were Greg Hogan, Sole Commissioner, Tommy Parker, County Manager, Edward Dunn, and Tina Choate, County Clerk.

The first order of business was to approve the agenda for today's meeting. The Commissioner, Greg Hogan, asked if anyone in attendance had any additional items to add to the agenda or if there are any requests to delete items from today's agenda. There were no addition or deletion requests. The Commissioner approved the agenda as written for April 4, 2023.

The next order of business was to approve the minutes for previous meeting(s) in the month of March (2023). The Commissioner reviewed and **approved** the Minutes as written for the March 7, 2023, Murray County Commissioner's Meeting.

New business was next on the agenda. Under new business the following items were discussed:

Item A: The Sole Commissioner, Greg Hogan, reviewed and **approved** the actions of the Planning Commission as written in the Minutes of the Murray County Land Use and Development Planning Commission Meeting held on March 21, 2023.

Item B: Commissioner Hogan presented information regarding a capital purchase in the amount of \$266,400.00 made on 2/28/2023. 6 Ford (Explorer) police interceptors (\$44,400.00 each) were purchased from Brannen Motor Co., for the Sheriff's Office. The capital purchase will be paid from ARPA Funds.

Item C: Greg Hogan, Commissioner, gave information on a \$55,671.56 capital purchase. On 3/20/2023 a Ford F-350 was purchased from Chatsworth Ford for the Murray County Fire Department. The capital purchase will be paid from SPLOST funds.

Item D: Murray County Government Disposal of Surplus- The following item(s) were **approved** by the Murray County Commissioner to be sold and or disposed of:

- Hydraulic Cylinder - Compactor
- Transmission Jack

Item E: The Sole Commissioner of Murray County, Greg Hogan, signed a Proclamation to proclaim the week of April 23-29, 2023, and each year that follows, as **Crime Victims' Rights Week**.

The Sole Commissioner of Murray County, Greg Hogan, adjourned the meeting at approximately 9:18 a.m.
