



MURRAY COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S MEETING

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Summary

Murray County Commissioner's Meeting May 2, 2023

The Sole Commissioner of Murray County, Greg Hogan, called the meeting to order promptly at 9:00A.M., May 2, 2023, in the Hearing Room of the Murray County Annex. In attendance were Greg Hogan, Sole Commissioner, Tommy Parker, County Manager, Billy Childers, Tax Commissioner, Larry Sampson, Registrar, Erik Green, Chatsworth Times representative, and Tina Davis, County Clerk.

The first order of business was to approve the agenda for today's meeting. The Commissioner, Greg Hogan, asked if anyone had any additional items to add to the agenda or if there are any requests to delete items from today's agenda. There were no addition or deletion requests. The Commissioner approved the agenda as written for May 2, 2023.

The next order of business was to approve the minutes for two previous meetings in the month of April 2023. The April 4, 2023, Commissioner's Meeting, and April 4, 2023, the Paving BID Opening Public Meeting. The Commissioner reviewed and **approved** the Minutes as written for April 4, 2023, Murray County Commissioner's Meeting, and the Paving BID Opening Public Meeting held on April 4, 2023.

New business was next on the agenda. Under new business the following items were discussed:

Item A: The Sole Commissioner, Greg Hogan, reviewed and **approved** the actions of the Planning Commission as written in the Minutes of the Murray County Land Use and Development Planning Commission Meeting held on April 18, 2023.

Item B: The Commissioner initiated the **1st Reading** to Amend Chapter 18 BUILDINGS AND BUILDING CONSTRUCTION*, Article II, Construction Codes, DIVISION 2, ATTACHMENT A ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT*, Sec. 18-60, Unlawful Acts. & Sec. 18-61, Unlawful continuance. 2nd Reading for the amendment is scheduled for June 6, 2023, at 9:00A.M. in the Annex Building Hearing Room.

Item C: Commissioner Hogan announced the capital purchase of an open top waste container for Murray County Collection Site(s). The open top waste container was purchased from WasteQuip in Charlotte, N.C. in the amount of \$6056.00. The total amount of the waste container will be paid for with ARPA Funds.

Item D: Greg Hogan, Commissioner, shared the specifics of another capital purchase. A 2023 F-550 Crew Cab truck (VIN: 1FD0W5HN4PEC10489) was purchased for the Murray County Fire Department. The F-550 was purchased from Chatsworth Ford. The total cost for the F-550 was \$65,292.16 and was paid from 2019 SPLOST Funds.

Item E: The Commissioner, Greg Hogan, gave information on a capital purchase for 2 lightbars to outfit the recently purchased F-350 (VIN: 1FT8W3BN2PEC44239) and F-550 (VIN: 1FD0W5HN4PEC10489). The equipment for the vehicles was purchased from West Chatham Warning Devices in Savannah, GA. The total cost of the lightbar equipment is \$4,237.20 to be paid from 2019 SPLOST funds.


Item F: Commissioner Hogan discussed and signed a contract with Traylor Business Services, Inc. to provide business personal property assessments for 12 months beginning March 17, 2023. The purpose of the contract with TBS is to assure that equal treatment is provided to all taxpayers by establishing a verification program to examine accounts. The total cost as set forth in the contract signed today is \$16,500 and will be paid out of the General Fund.


Item G: Commissioner Hogan presented an amendment to the FY2022 Budget for FY2022 audit compliance.
